2019/20 BUDGET

Your Money—2019/2020

The money needed for the budget comes from the precept raised and income. Paulton Parish Council has raised a precept of £219,808 for 2019/20. This is an annual charge of £110.73 for a Band D property in Paulton which equates to £2.13 per week. The Parish Council has kept the increase to a minimum but due to taking on Paulton Hub an increase of £0.03p per week was unavoidable. A breakdown of how this will be spent is shown below.
