DELEGATED POWERS	The committee is authorised to make decisions on behalf of Paulton Parish Council with regard to all aspects in the Terms of Reference and within the budget up to £5000 in accordance with the Financial Regulations.
REFERRED BUSINESS	The Committee is authorised to make decisions in relation to the ongoing maintenance and furnishings within the Memorial Park and Miners Recreation Park. Decisions resulting in a change to the landscape will be referred to the Trustees of the Charity.

FREQUENCY OF MEETINGS	Every 3 months
