

<b>NAME OF COMMITTEE</b>	<b>Parks and Amenities</b>
<b>COUNCILLOR MEMBERSHIP</b>	9 members of the Parish Council
<b>REQUIREMENT</b>	Members on the committee must be willing to do research, get involved with specific projects possibly via working parties and provide reports for the committee if necessary.
<b>TERMS OF REFERENCE</b>	<p>(i) The committee will, on behalf of the Council, have responsibility for the Memorial Park, Miners Recreation Ground, Wallenge Open Space, Cemetery, Wildlife areas, War Memorial, *footpaths, *bus shelters, *street furniture, ground maintenance, heritage, toilets, and allotments.</p> <p>(ii) Cemetery – oversee the management, review fees and regulations and recommend changes to full Parish Council, oversee the management of cemetery chapel and buildings</p> <p>(iii) To work with the Council's staff for the improvement and development of allotments, wildlife areas, open spaces, street furniture and other public spaces in the village area.</p> <p>(iv) Encourage the provision and maintenance of Street Furniture including: - bus shelters, street lighting, notice boards, seats, cycle racks and bins</p> <p>(v) Consider heritage areas in the village.</p> <p>(vi) To deal with relevant matters relating to the creation, diversion, and closure of public rights of way and open green spaces.</p> <p><i>* some are the responsibility of others such as B&amp;NES Council and Curo.</i></p>
<b>DELEGATED POWERS</b>	The committee is authorised to make decisions on behalf of Paulton Parish Council with regard to all aspects in the Terms of <b>Reference and within the budget up to £5000 in accordance with the Financial Regulations.</b>
<b>REFERRED BUSINESS</b>	The Committee is authorised to make decisions in relation to the ongoing maintenance and furnishings within the Memorial Park and Miners Recreation Park. Decisions resulting in a change to the landscape will be referred to the Trustees of the Charity.
<b>QUORUM</b>	3 members of the committee
<b>FREQUENCY OF MEETINGS</b>	Every 3 months
