## 6. <u>WIFI UPGRADE</u>

Soltech have again visited the area to test the internet speed in the area. Unfortunately, the area has particularly slow internet speed in the area, it has been pointed out that this would also have been the case before the transfer of the facility to Paulton Parish Council. The options below are limited and will not make a significant improvement as noted below:

- 1) To add a 2<sup>nd</sup> line. The filtering costs does not increase and a new line with internet service added costs around £45 a month, we will only know if a spare line is available on order.
- 2) Add a 4G router and set this up for customer access. A 4G data sim card is £32.50 a month and the one-time cost of the router is £250.00, this is a less reliable option and not recommended
- 3) Wait for BT to upgrade their cabinet, we are not aware of plans to do this yet.
- 4) Do not allow public access to the WIFI, reducing the access to the Library systems only will increase the speed. If the café wish to have WIFI then they would have to put in a separate line.
