## **03-24 - REQUEST FOR A WASTE BIN IN THE RED LION CAR PARK**

**Resolved** for the council to supply the bin with Cllr Lyons proposing and Cllr Easter seconding the motion.

## **04-24 - QUOTE FOR A NEW DOOR FOR THE PUBLIC CONVENIENCE IN THE RED LION CAR PARK**
